Introduction

This Privacy Policy discloses the privacy practices for Peek to Peak Home Inspections, LLC. (the “Company”) and its website peektopeakhomeinspections.com (“Website”). We hold the privacy of your personal information in the highest regard. The following discloses our information gathering and dissemination practices for this website.

We recognize the importance of protecting your privacy and our policy is designed to assist you in understanding how we collect, use, and safeguard the personal information you provide to us and to assist you in making informed decisions when using our site. This policy will be continuously assessed against new technologies, business practices, and our customer’s needs.

What Information Do We Collect?

When you sign up for coaching or when you visit the Website, you may provide us with two types of information: personal information you knowingly choose to disclose that is collected on an individual basis and website use information collected on an aggregate basis as you and others browse our Website.

What is Sensitive Information?

Racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religion, trade union or other professional association or memberships, philosophical beliefs, sexual orientation or practices, criminal records; Health information (Biometric information, etc.).

Where personal information that is also sensitive information is collected for a particular purpose i.e. the primary purpose, we will not disclose it for another purpose i.e. a secondary purposes unless:

- The client/customer would reasonably expect the company to use or disclose such sensitive information for the secondary purpose; and
- The secondary purpose is directly related to the primary purpose.

Sensitive information may also be disclosed if:

- The disclosure is required under United States law;
- A permitted general situation exists;
- A permitted health situation exists; or
- The company reasonably believes that the use or disclosure of such information is necessary for an enforcement related activity conducted by or on behalf of an enforcement body.

2. REGISTRATION INFORMATION

When you register for any of our products, services, or newsletters you will provide us information about yourself, including information considered sensitive information as described above.

3. EMAIL INFORMATION

If you choose to correspond with us through email, we may retain the content of your email messages together with your email address and our responses. We provide the same protections for these electronic communications that we employ in the maintenance of information received by mail and telephone. This also applies when you register for our website, sign up through any of our forms using your email address or make a purchase on this site.

4. WEBSITE USE INFORMATION

Similar to other commercial websites, our Website utilizes a standard technology called cookies (see explanation below, What Are Cookies?) and web server log files to collect information about how our Website is used. Information gathered through cookies and web server logs may include the date and time of visits, the pages viewed, time spent at our Website, and the websites visited just before and just after our Website, as well as your anonymized IP address. The information we collect automatically is used for statistical data and will not include personal information. We use this data to improve our website(s) and our service offerings.

How And Why We Collect Information

The Company collects your information in order to record and support your participation in the activities you select. If you register to download a book or other resources, sign up for our newsletter, enroll in a program, and/or purchase a product from us, we collect your information. We use this information to track your preferences and to keep you informed about the products and services you have selected to receive and any related products and/or services. As a visitor to this Website, you can engage in most activities without providing any personal information. It is only when you seek to download resources and/or register for services that you are required to provide information.

How Do We Use the Information That You Provide to Us?

We use personal information for purposes of presenting our Website and its contents to you, providing you with information, providing you with offers for products and services, providing you with information about your subscriptions and products, carrying out any contract between you and the Company, administering our business activities, providing customer service, and making available other items and services to our customers and prospective Customers.

From time-to-time, we may use the information you provide to us to make you offers to purchase products and services provided by third parties in exchange for a commission to be paid to us by such third parties. Should you opt to take part in such promotions, the third parties will receive your information.

Disclosure Of Your Information

As a general rule, we do not sell, rent, lease or otherwise transfer any information collected whether automatically or through your voluntary action.

We may disclose your personal information to our subsidiaries and service providers for the purpose of providing our services to you.

We may disclose your personal information to a third party, including to a lawyer or collection agency, when necessary to enforce our terms of service or any other agreement between you and the Company.

We may provide your information to any successor in interest in the event of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of the Company's assets and/or business.

We may disclose information when legally compelled to do so, in other words, when we, in good faith, believe that the law requires it or for the protection of our legal rights or when compelled by a court or other governmental entity to do so.

What Are Cookies?

A cookie is a very small text document, which often includes an anonymous unique identifier. When you visit a website, that site's computer asks your computer for permission to store this file in a part of your hard drive specifically designated for cookies. Each website can send its own cookie to your browser if your browser's preferences allow it, but (to protect your privacy) your browser only permits a Website to access the cookies it has already sent to you,

not the cookies sent to you by other sites. Browsers are usually set to accept cookies. However, if you would prefer not to receive cookies, you may alter the configuration of your browser to refuse cookies. If you choose to have your browser refuse cookies, it is possible that some areas of our site will not function as effectively when viewed by the users. A cookie cannot retrieve any other data from your hard drive or pass on computer viruses.

How Do We Use Information We Collect from Cookies?

As you visit and browse our Website, the site uses cookies in an effort to provide you with an excellent user experience. In some cases, we also use cookies to prevent you from having to log in more than is necessary for security. Cookies, in conjunction with our web server's log files, allow us to calculate the aggregate number of people visiting our Website and which parts of the site are most popular. This helps us gather feedback to constantly improve our Website and better serve our clients. Other than as described in this Privacy Policy, cookies do not allow us to gather any personal information about you and we do not intentionally store any personal information that your browser provided to us in your cookies.

The Company reserves the right to use technological equivalents of cookies, including social media pixels. These pixels allow social media sites to track visitors to outside websites so as to tailor advertising messages users see while visiting that social media website. The Company reserves the right to use these pixels in compliance with the policies of the various social media sites.

What are Dynamic Ads?

Dynamic Ads are ads that are personalized in real-time to the user. Unlike static ads that show the same content on every impression, Dynamic Ads enable the advertiser to display a unique creative for different users. Dynamic Ads are the only feasible way to scale up the number of creatives per campaign and to personalize them on each impression.

What is Retargeting?

The main goal of Retargeting Ads is to re-engage site visitors after they have left the site. Dynamic Retargeting Ads are generated based on the actual products or offers viewed on the advertiser's site. For example, if you've visited a retailer's website and viewed a specific product, you might receive a banner ad containing that product. Rather than showing the same ad to every visitor, Peek to Peak Home Inspections, LLC's Dynamic Ad Application will select the most relevant ad copy based on the user's activity on the site. Peek to Peak Home Inspections, LLC's Personalized Retargeting Platform works when an advertiser places our tag on their website. The tag embeds a third party cookie on the browser of users visiting the site.

Using Real Time Bidding (RTB) Ad Exchanges, it is then possible to focus media buying efforts against those visitors. It is important to note that, except as otherwise described in this Privacy Policy the cookie itself does not contain any personal identifying information. Our Personalized Retargeting ads intelligently match the right offering to each visitor based on his previous activities on the site. Each advertiser using Peek to Peak Home Inspections, LLC.'s services is responsible for limiting the number of ad impressions shown to each user in order to ensure that viewers are not overly exposed to specific ads.

How Can I Remove Myself from Being Retargeted?

IP Addresses
